

MAINTAINING SHUTTERS

- Rotate blades daily.
- Keep any tracks free of dirt and grit weekly. Use a silicone spray lubricant if necessary.
- Regularly clean blades with a soft slightly damp cloth to remove dust.
- Fusion shutters may be cleaned with a mild diluted dishwashing liquid and a soft cloth, or a mild base household cleaner for more difficult dirt and stains.
- External shutters should be hosed down regularly and washed with a mild soap solution to remove air pollutants and salt residue in coastal areas.
- Always rinse afterwards with fresh water so that the contact time of the cleaning solution is kept to a minimum.
- Do not use undue weight or pressure on the blades whilst wiping.
- If any blades come loose, use the tension screw to tighten again (located at the side of the shutter panel).



“ NEVER USE hot water, alcohol, silicon-based sprays, solvents, chlorine-based cleaners, steel wool, scourers or abrasive cleaners on shutters as they may affect the surface appearance and durability. ”
